



DOÑA ISIDORA RIESLING 2009



In the nineteenth century, Luis Cousiño and his wife, Isidora, brought back from Germany Riesling cuttings. The genetic integrity of these plants has been maintained by mass selection in the winery's vine nurseries. This is the true Riesling, known as Johannisberg Riesling in the Old World and White Riesling in the New World. Cultivated for more than a century in the Maipo Valley, the Cousiño-Macul Rieslings have developed a leading personality.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The 2009 season presented great conditions for the maturation of white grapes. A cold winter with normal rainfall and a warm and dry summer resulted in white wines of excellent quality, with attractive aromas and vibrant acidity.

WINEMAKING

The fruit was harvested early in the morning and hand-selected in the winery. The pressing was done with the whole bunch. To enhance the floral character of the variety the fermentation was slow with temperatures fluctuating between 12° and 13 ° C (54°-55 ° F), the fermentation lasted 27 days. After this a small filtration is done before bottling.

TASTING NOTES

With a beautiful bright yellow color, this Riesling has an intense floral nose, mild aromas of apple blossom and limes can be found. The mouth is full and suggests a slight sweetness. This wine has a fine acidity and very good body.

HARMONY

Doña Isidora is ideal for spicy dishes.
